The proposal seeks consent for alterations and additions to a dwelling including a new extension to the rear, changes to the roof and new decks. The heritage item is located to the south east, south and west of the subject site as the reserve wraps around the street. However the subject property does not directly adjoin the reserve due to Barrabooka Street at the front and the House Street road reserve (unformed) to the rear. The proposed works are considered to not impact upon the heritage item or its significance.
