Building and Development | Rezoning Applications

Rezoning Applications

A rezoning is a formal planning process which, when complete, alters the range of a permissible on a site. This may increase or decrease the range of permissible uses f

Council is currently undertaking a major review of our Planning Scheme, known as F LEP. Should you be considering lodging a rezoning application you are advised to co Senior Strategic Planner to ascertain the best course of action at this stage.

Rezoning or more correctly amendment of Council's Local Environmental Plan, is an Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, and must be carried out in accordance

The following charges apply:

Minor Rezoning - \$9,000.00 + \$110.00 per hour after initial 40 hour assessment Major Rezonlngs - \$13,000.00 + \$110.00 per hour after initial 80 hour assessme

Presently there is no right of appeal against Council's decision on the merits of rezor no refund of fees for an unsuccessful rezoning. A partial refund may be available if the withdrawn before Council makes a decision on it or if Council resolves not to exhibit rezoning/amendment.

The key steps in considering a rezoning application are:

- Preliminary exhibition of the proposal.
- Analysis of any submissions and a Report to Council on the rezoning proposa
- Decision by Council as to whether to proceed with exhibition of draft LEP.
- Concurrence of the Minister for Planning to the preparation of a draft LEP.
- Public exhibition of draft LEP (28 days) and notification of relevant authorities.
- Report back to Council regarding results of exhibition, submissions etc, for res whether to proceed with rezoning.
- Report to DUAP requesting LEP be made.
- Signature of plan by Minister and Governor.
- Gazettal

After receiving any rezoning application Council exhibits the proposal and advises at The community may make written submissions during this exhibition period. If the Co exhibit a draft local environmental plan, the public has another opportunity to view th comment on its content. Apart from placing an advertisement in the newspaper advis community of the exhibition, Council will notify in writing those residents and property may be affected by the draft plan. Council must take into consideration submissions when it makes a decision whether or not to proceed with the rezoning.

Council considers the following matters when it determines your rezoning app

- The Objects of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act;
- The relevant heads of consideration for development applications (as detailed 79c of the EP& A Act;
- Any relevant State or regional environmental policies, circulars or Ministerial c
