CONSTRUCTION OF MEDICAL TREATMENT CENTRE – 49 FRENCHS FOREST ROAD, FRENCHS FOREST

Reference is made to Council's correspondence dated 23 September 2019, regarding the abovementioned Application which was referred to Roads and Maritime Services (Roads and Maritime) for comment in accordance with Schedule 3 of *State Environmental Planning Policy* (*Infrastructure*) 2007.

Roads and Maritime has reviewed the submitted application and provides the following comments for Council's consideration in the determination of this application:

 A strip of land has previously been dedicated as Public Road by private subdivision (DP108202), along the Warringah Road frontage of the subject property, as shown by yellow colour on the attached Aerial – "X".

All buildings and structures (including signage), together with any improvements integral to the future use of the site are wholly within the freehold property (unlimited in height or depth), along the Warringah Road boundary.

The subject property is also within an area under investigation for potential Northern Beaches Hospital Roadworks Project. - 2. Access is denied across the property boundary to Warringah Road.
- 3. Detailed design plans and hydraulic calculations of any changes to the stormwater drainage system are to be submitted to Roads and Maritime for approval, prior to the commencement of any works. Please send all documentation to development.sydney@rms.nsw.gov.au

A plan checking fee will be payable and a performance bond may be required before Roads and Maritime approval is issued.

Roads and Maritime Services

- 4. The swept path of the longest vehicle (including garbage trucks, building maintenance vehicles and removalists) entering and exiting the subject site, as well as manoeuvrability through the site, shall be in accordance with AUSTROADS.
- 5. The layout of the proposed car parking areas associated with the subject development (including, driveways, grades, turn paths, sight distance requirements in relation to landscaping and/or fencing, aisle widths, aisle lengths, and parking bay dimensions) should be in accordance with AS 2890.1-2004 and AS2890.6-2009.
- 6. All demolition and construction vehicles are to be contained wholly within the site and vehicles must enter the site before stopping. A construction zone will not be permitted on Warringah Road.
- 7. A Road Occupancy Licence (ROL) should be obtained from Transport Management Centre for any works that may impact on traffic flows on Warringah Road during construction activities. A ROL can be obtained through https://myrta.com/oplinc2/pages/security/oplincLogin.jsf
- 8. A Construction Traffic Management Plan detailing construction vehicle routes, number of trucks, hours of operation, access arrangements and traffic control should be submitted to Council for approval prior to the issue of a Construction Certificate.
- Any temporary and/or permanent relocation of utility services adjacent to the Roads and Maritime road corridor requires prior consultation and approval from Roads and Maritime Services.
