At present there is a senate committee into the faunal extinction crisis in Australia. Yet nothing seems to be changing to protect our fauna.

This block of land is foraging territory for powerful owls, a threatened species in NSW. Their presence has been noted here for at least a decade.

Removing the bushland will force them to forage out into the surrounding suburb where they are at risk of car-strike. According to Birdlife Australia car-strike is a major cause of death for Powerful owls.

Removing the bushland also removes their food source which is predominantly ringtail and brushtail possum.

I am of the opinion that a reasonable amount of this property has already been developed.

I also did not note any plans to reduce the carbon footprint of the proposed building either during the building phase not when its eventually built. Although not mandatory, I would expect in the best interests for society, an effort by the developer towards a low carbon development
