
We have viewed the proposed plans of above redevelopment and wish to register our strong objection as follows:

- 1. While the subject property has a Carrington Street address, all access i.e. front door access and garages are accessed and located in Gardere Avenue as they always have been. Accordingly, the subject development should have the same setbacks as Gardere Avenue properties or the same rear setbacks that currently apply to existing Carrington Avenue properties.
- 2. The proposed bulk of the development is a gross over development of the site.
- 3. No provision of setbacks for open space as per Council Policy.
- 4. Lack of landscaped area as required by Part D1 of WDCP 2011.
- 5. Non compliance of planning controls.
- 6. We will suffer significant loss of primary views to the south including Fairy Bower and the Cardinal's Palace, Manly.
