Re Application PP0005/16 In recent times Northern Beaches Council proposed increasing the density and character of Mona Vale Town centre to cope with the anticipated increase in population expected in the Warriewood Valley and Ingleside. There are many additional thousands of new residents that will want to shop and work from our area - placing increasing pressure on our infrastructure. Rather than disrupt existing residents in nearby shopping areas this development would be a much better solution.
