Reason for application and outline of proposed work

There are three paperbark trees situated on strata common property. Two of these paperbark trees are located next to a deep concrete Sydney Water stormwater pit/drain. During past heavy rains the stormwater drain has flooded on numerous occasions due to water flowing from a large inlet pipe to a smaller outlet pipe. This excess water over time has eroded a significant amount of soil from the base of these paperbark trees exposing the roots. These two trees appear to be unstable and leaning towards a neighbouring building at 1 Campbell Parade, Manly Vale and the dividing fence. This building is approximately 4 metres from the base of these two trees. There is a third paperbark tree in the close vicinity of the other two trees which could in time be affected by soil erosion from the stormwater drain and is approximately 4 metres from the neighbouring building.

The three paperbark trees are located on common property which can be accessed from the garden area of townhouse number 15. The trees are approximately 20 metres east of the green picket fence of the visitors carparking area adjacent to townhouse number 15. The trees are close to the southwest corner of the light industrial complex at 1 Campbell Parade, Manly Vale. The three paperbark trees have been marked each with a piece of green nylon rope around them. Two paperbark trees closest to the stormwater pit/drain are marked number 1 and 2 and the third tree slightly to the north of the other two trees is marked number 3 in the diagram.
