Our concerns are summarised as follows:

- * •Reduced safety due to channel congestion: Our family and friends love kayaking and Stand Up Paddling Boarding in North Harbour and around to Forty Baskets beach. It's activities and places like these that are key to the magic of the Northern Beaches. The channel is already busy with moorings and vessels. Increasing this will prohibit use for all non-motorised vessels, making it unsafe.
- *•Eyesore impacting local and visitor attraction: The marina will introduce walls of boats blocking views, along with increased rubbish and congestion, detracting from the beauty and appeal of the area.
- * •Increased parking demand and traffic: We object to the introduction of a kiosk. There are
 already two in the near vicinity (Forty Beans, and North Harbour Sailing Club). An additional
 kiosk will exceed demands on already limited parking, increase traffic on a road that is shared by
 pedestrians and cars, not to mention cannibalise the two existing small businesses.
- * Noise pollution: Likely increased noise from sea and land traffic and additional people.
