Statement of Significance

The Grove of Cabbage Tree Palms (Livistona australis) is a landscape heritage item of local significance with natural, aesthetic, scientific, historic and social significance for the Pittwater local government area. Strong and densely established, this grove is emblematic of Bilgola as a locality within the larger peninsula and municipality. The occurrence of cabbage tree palms, said to be the best remaining stand in the Sydney area, add to the natural beauty of the area. The area is an important recreational resource for the people of Sydney.

Physical Description

The Grove of Cabbage Tree Palms in the Bilgola Valley covers several properties to the east and west of Barrenjoey Road in Bilgola.
