Glenrose place; currently used for access to Glenrose shops only, with 1 pedestrian crossing; now you want to add 200 cars, with kids using the crossing on a regular basis after 3pm; also, people accessing new development will park in Glenrose, walk out on to Glenrose place to get to new development. Belrose/Davidson doesn't need a 12.5 metre tower. Down the road is 3 stories, plenty. Note: they bought the site in 2013 with 8.5 metre height limit; stick to it.
