We **object** to the proposal for management of stormwater because it will NOT meet the requirements of the LEP, DCP and Water Management for Development Policy (Northern Beaches Council) to:

* improve the quality of water discharged to our natural areas to protect the ecological and recreational condition of our waterways, riparian areas and bushland.

The project modifications are showing an Alternate Discharge Approach with the creation of 8 stormwater outlets.
