1. Objective

To ensure that the children and adults of the School are safe at all times, and the Church's buildings and equipment, that are used within the School's leased area, are secure.

2. Security at School's Site

2.1 Students

Yanginanook School places a very high priority on the security of its students and will take all reasonable steps to ensure they are kept safe from physical and mental harm while at School.

2.2 Visitors

Any visitors to the School site, who are not parents or members of the School Community, are required to report to the Head Teacher on arrival. The Head Teacher, or appropriate adult, will attend to the visitor, ensure they sign in according to QR code COVID19 regulations and monitor their movements.

Older students are taught that upon seeing a stranger on the property they will immediately inform the Teacher on duty.

2.3 Buildings/Facilities

At the end of each day all blinds are closed and all windows and doors to the School site are locked.

The adults of the School Community, who are the last to leave the premises, must ensure that all blinds are closed and all windows and doors are locked.

Clint and Jennifer Staj live in the adjoining dwelling. Jennifer is the Chairman of Yanginanook School's Board and Clint is the employed Youth Pastor of Frenchs Forest Baptist Church. As neighbours, they have sight of the School site when arriving and leaving their property and are in a position to report any security issues that come to their attention.

If any member of the School Community requires access to the School's site building, outside of school hours (for cleaning or maintenance work), they may gain access through Clint Staj. For permission to access the School's site building, School community members are requested to contact the Head Teacher during school hours or Jennifer Staj outside of school hours.

2.4 Evacuation or Lockdown Procedures

Located at each door is a copy of the Church's Evacuation Plan and a whistle to sound an emergency.
