On what is already a narrow busy shopping strip, with exits and entrances from Roseberry St. The volume of traffic, including large trucks on any day of the week, up to 9pm for Aldi and Bunnings stores already forces a vehicle exiting Aldi and needing to return to Kenneth Rd to turn left because crossing Roseberry St is impossible to get a sight-line we are forced to join a line of traffic to enter an already crowded roundabout just to leave Roseberry Street ..

The suggestion that a commercial enterprise would have the power to re-design roads is ludicrous. The question of who bears that cost springs to mind .
