At the moment the Bowlers are playing at Manly and I understand the facilities cater to competition and social games. Plus getting together for after drinks. I cannot understand why there needs to be another bowling green in an area right in the middle of our retirement village.

If this bowling green were to go ahead I'm not sure what our feelings would be about remaining at the village.
