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Officer Comments

Proposal

The site at 12 and 14 Gladys Avenue, Frenchs Forest, currently comprises two detached dwelling houses. The proposal is for the demolition of the existing dwellings and the construction of a seniors housing development incorporating nineteen (19) infill self-care housing units (2 x 2-bedroom and 17 x 3-bedroom) and basement car parking for 28 vehicles.

The proposed development is located within the R2 zone, and seniors housing, as defined by the Warringah Local Environmental Plan (WLEP) 2011, is prohibited within this zone. However, the use remains permissible with consent via the operation of SEPP Housing and clause 1.9 of WLEP 2011.

Hospital Precinct Structure Plan

In August 2017, Council adopted the Northern Beaches Hospital Precinct Structure Plan (Structure Plan) to guide land use planning decisions in Frenchs Forest over the next 20 years. The subject site is located outside the Structure Plan's Phase 1 area but is in proximity to the future town centre identified for R2 (Low Density) development. This future residential uplift is concentrated around the proposed future town centre site next to the hospital.

The site falls within the 'Future Investigation' area, with no current implications for zoning or land use permissibility. The Structure Plan does not propose any changes to

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the site's zoning, land use permissibility, or development controls. The site's 'Future Investigation' label does not impose restrictions on developments consistent with current planning controls.

Conclusion

The proposal is considered acceptable in terms of Council's Strategic Planning.
