My Wife and myself have been living in the "Dardanelles" section of the War Veterans Village on Collaroy Plateau for three years.

In all this time a lot of elderly people, including Myself, have had a lot of problems with mobile phone and Internet connections and availability.

I have noticed people having to go outside their Units, in all weathers, sometimes as far as the waters edge of the Lake, to make or receive mobile calls.

As our independent living units, 130 of them, are at the lowest point of the War Vet's property, some of us approached the Management about the problem.

Over 12 months ago they said they would look into providing a single pole mast to hopefully fix the problem.

Now it appears that because of objections from people, some from within the village, who may not understand, but also from outside the village, all of whom live higher

up the hill in Lantana Ave. and with probably very good reception, that this project may not go ahead..

We at the lower side of the property desperately need this Communication Mast to go ahead, and as there is considerably more building work going on now, and more planned for

2022, a lot more people will be living on this vast property, and a Tower like this will be an essential part of life for a lot more elderly residents.
