01 Moore Road streetscape improvements

- share path to promote active travel (northside)
- street tree planting (southside)

02 Redesign access and carparking

- consolidated carparking arrangement and road profile to adjust levels
- pedestrian access connections to open space
- increase existing parking 44 to 50 spaces (3 disabled)
- allow for heavy vehicle turning access
- drop-off and pick-up zones
- native shade tree planting within carpark

03 Open space and recreation

- improve useability of open space area for family recreation and passive recreation including:
 - + large open spaces
 - + terraced grass area with shade provisions
 - + shade tree planting
 - + picnic facilities and comfort provisions
 - + connected access to surrounding areas

04 Connected pedestrian network

- improve pedestrian accessibility connecting Freshwater Beach Reserve
- improve pedestrian safety

05 Connected pedestrian network

- improve pedestrian accessibility along Undercliff Rd
- improve pedestrian safety
- pathway to be suspended along road edge, including viewing platform and seating
- continue weed removal program

14 Redesign access and carparking

- consolidated carparking arrangement
- pedestrian access connections to open space
- provision of open space between carpark and access connections
- increase existing 146 to 180 spaces (4 disabled)
- change existing overflow parking to permanent
- relocate Council's Life Guard building
- allow for heavy vehicle turning access at end of Kooloora Ave with carspaces reduced from 18 to 12
- drop-off and pick-up zones

13 Connected pedestrian and cycle network

connecting open space to surrounding areas

12 Shared access zone within Reserve

- 'soft' accessway to Surf Club carpark

11 Relocated playground

- located within large open space area
- close proximity to activities and services

10 At grade surface road treatment

- provide pedestrian connection to footpaths
- subject to further investigations and approval by RMS

15 Open space and recreation

- open space transition area between carpark and beach useable for varied recreational and social activities, including:
 - social gathering, with picnic facilities and shade
 - connected access to surrounding areas
 - operational beach access
 - remove first row of existing parking and aisle to increase open space

16 Beach Viewing Platform

- access from connected share path

17 Beach Access

- emergency and operational access

18 Redesign access and carparking

- allow for heavy vehicle turning access at end of Ocean View Road with carspaces reduced from 15 to 14 (2 disabled)
- drop-off and pick-up zones

19 At grade surface road treatment

- provide pedestrian connection to footpaths
- subject to further investigations and approval by RMS

20 Connected Pedestrian Network

- all access provision to Freshwater Pool
- at grade path from Ocean View Rd, the a raised boardwalk and path network over sand to existing path

09 Recreation and public space 'hub'

- 'public meeting place'
- parkland open space, supporting family orientated activities and use, including social interaction - relocated playground, outdoor fitness area, outdoor deck/stage for events or as outdoor meeting area
- historical significance to be enhanced as a landscape theme
- continued vehicle access to service Surf Club, with access priority to pedestrians
- connected access to surrounding areas

08 Public amenities

- kiosk / cafe and public amenities building with change rooms, showers and toilets to serve community and Surf Club
- subject to funding

07 Open space and passive recreation

- to enhance beach and ocean views within a parkland open space setting, generating family orientated activities and use
- landscape elements to include: children's play area, provision of shade, access, open space visibility, and activities
- vehicular access prohibited except for emergency and rescue services

06 Foredune rehabilitation

- management of dune profile and dune vegetation
- ongoing dune stabilisation program through funded programs
- maintain beach access

Connected pedestrian network

- improve pedestrian accessibility connecting Freshwater Beach Reserve
- improve pedestrian safety
- investigate path lighting

Connected pedestrian network

- improve pedestrian accessibility along Undercliff Road
- improve pedestrian safety
- investigate path lighting
- pathway to be suspended along road edge, including viewing platform and seating

03

Connected pedestrian network

- improve pedestrian accessibility and safety
- widen footpath and realign within Council verge
- formalise parallel parking
- viewing platform and seating to capture Freshwater Beach views

04

At grade surface road treatment

- provide pedestrian connection to footpaths to reduce driver/pedestrian conflict
- subject to further investigations and approval by RMS

05

Connected pedestrian network

- improve pedestrian accessibility and safety
- realign road kerb to ensure suitable footpath width and access to driveways

06

Existing stairs and footpath

- widen steps and footpath to improve safety and improve visual connection
- realign road kerb to ensure suitable footpath width
- subject to future walking strategy studies

07

Connected pedestrian network

- improve pedestrian accessibility to Freshwater View Reserve
- improve pedestrian safety
- investigate path lighting

08

Existing stormwater improvements

- continue stormwater control and management programs
- embellish open stormwater to achieve a natural creek environment

09

Existing stairs and footpaths

- general maintenance to ensure safety
- investigate opportunities for additional bike tracking access up and down stairs

10

Coastal Escarpment

- monitor cliff stability
- continue existing vegetation control and regeneration program
- general maintenance of walking tracks to ensure safety

11

Pavilion Reserve

- improve open space recreation opportunities
- provide comfort zone for enjoying south view, with provision of seating and shade tree planting
- connecting path along Bridge Rd to include seating wall and retention of existing mounding

12

Freshwater View Reserve

- improve viewing opportunities through vegetation management
- investigate safety provisions at cliffs edge, whilst maintaining existing safety and warning signage
- provide comfort zone for enjoying north view, with provision of decking and seating

13

Freshwater View Reserve

- preserve open space character
- enhance viewing opportunities through improved comfort areas (seating and soft pavement)
- provide shade tree planting
- enhance opportunities for community use, including weddings, events etc

Connected pedestrian network

- connecting open space to surrounding areas

Connected boardwalk to pool walkway

- raised above sand level to reduce sandune impact
- accessible travel, including access for immobile, pedestrians and cyclists
- final alignment subject to geotechnical investigations and detailed levels and construction analysis

- investigate options to improve water quality

Existing walkway to Pool

- upgrade to provide accessible travel

Viewing Platform

- protect existing dune profile and vegetation

Connected pedestrian and cycle network

- management of dune profile and dune vegetation
- ongoing dune stabilisation program through funded programs
- maintain beach access

08

At grade surface road treatment

- provide pedestrian connection to footpaths
- subject to further investigations and approval by RMS

Existing Escarpment

- develop management strategy for vegetation control and regeneration

10

Possible Activation Space

- potential kiosk, cafe etc. including improved accessibility
- subject to further engagement

Connected accessibility

- investigate options for improvements to existing footpaths and cycle access
- establish pedestrian connections to Diggers forecourt

14

Connected path/boardwalk to headland

- all access to Curl Curl coastal walkway
- indicative alignment only
- final alignment subject to site survey and levels

13

Public open space

- connected to surrounding areas and Harbord Diggers
- develop as passive space for community benefit
- enhance historically significant elements and spaces

Connected pedestrian network

- to enhance historical significance as part of pedestrian network
- opportunity to 'theme' this section, restore and further develop the existing Surfer's Walk

11

Public open space

- enhance view opportunities for the public in a natural setting, and upgrade areas for improved passive recreation amenity and comfort
- expand open space area at headland by removal of 13 car spaces to be relocated near entrance (nett loss / gain to the area)
- continue bushland revegetation program
- provide general maintenance improvements
