TREE MANAGEMENT ASSESSMENT

77 Myola Road Newport NSW 2106

Northern Beaches Council (28th October 2024)

The purpose of this document is to provide a "*Site Specific Tree Management Strategy/Plan*" relative to the soon to be lodged Development Application for Alterations & Additions to an existing dwelling including a double garage via shared driveway.

The subject site was visited on Saturday, 26 October 2024 by GMW representatives, Kyle A Hill & Ao Wang.

Our brief was to consider trees within the subject site within/adjacent to the existing right of way roadway. The proposed alterations & additions to the existing dwelling is confirmed to mathematically breach (by AS4970-2009) the discussed group of trees. The following identification / discussion (including photographs) confirms all vegetation (trees discussed) to be exempt, either by size &/or species.

The group of trees includes multiple *Olea europaea* subsp. *cuspidata* (African olive), one (1) *Pittosporum undulatum* (Sweet Pittosporum) and one (1) *Callistemon viminalis* (Weeping Bottlebrush).

By our interpretation of the Northen Beaches Council Exempt tree species list, all trees are exempt by size &/or species. (See following pages photographs.)

<u>Pittwater 21 Development Control Plan</u> - <u>Section B General Controls</u> - <u>B4 Controls</u> <u>Relating to the Natural Environment</u> - <u>B4.22 Preservation of Trees and Bushland</u> <u>Vegetation lists the following as exempt vegetation (trees):</u> 1. Trees under 5 metres in height

2. Pittosporum spp. (up to 8m)

3. Olea spp.

On this basis, the above trees, both individual specimens, or groups of same species specimens do not require any more detailed discussion.

Works, as proposed within the subject site are well below (by multiple natural soil horizon levels where it is reasonably able to be predicted, no 'live roots' of a significant diameter (defined to be in this circumstance greater than 500mm in diameter). See pages 2 & 3 photographs.
