General Comments

Proposed Mod is basically to remove 3 trees and roots as part of an existing approval.

The main approval conditions for the site relating to any Environmental Health concerns would remain in place.

However disturbance of undeclared contaminants in an area not previously excavated is a potential risk.

Therefore Environmental Health have no objections to the proposal subject to conditions.

The proposal is therefore supported.
