Officer comments

Th Arborists Report submitted with the application is noted. The report undertook root mapping to assess impacts of the widened driveway on an existing street tree. The results of the root mapping indicate that the works can be undertaken with an acceptable level of impact on the tree.

CONDITIONS THAT MUST BE ADDRESSED PRIOR TO ANY COMMENCEMENT

Tree protection

- (a) Existing trees which must be retained
- i) All trees not indicated for removal on the approved plans, unless exempt under relevant planning instruments or legislation
 - ii) Trees located on adjoining land
 - iii) All street trees.
- (b) Tree protection

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i) No tree roots greater than 25mm diameter are to be cut from protected trees unless authorised by the Project Arborist on site.

ii) All structures are to bridge tree roots greater than 25mm diameter unless directed otherwise by the Project Arborist on site.

iii) All tree protection to be in accordance with the Arboricultural Impact Assessment dated August 2019 prepared by Bluegum Tree Care and Consultancy and AS4970-2009 Protection of trees on development sites, with particular reference to Section 4 Tree Protection Measures.

iv) All tree pruning within the subject site is to be in accordance with WDCP2011 Clause
 E1 Private Property Tree Management and AS 4373 Pruning of amenity trees
 v) All tree protection measures, including fencing, are to be in place prior to commencement of works.

Reason: To ensure compliance with the requirement to retain and protect significant planting on the site.

Project Arborist

i) A Project Arborist with minimum qualification AQF Level 5 is to be appointed prior to commencement of works.

ii) The Project Arborist is to oversee all tree protection measures, removals and works adjacent to
protected trees as outlined in the Arboricultural Impact Assessment dated August 2019 prepared by
Bluegum Tree Care and Consultancy and AS4970-2009 Protection of trees on development sites.
 iii) The Project Arborist is to ensure compliance as relevant with any other environmental requirements
conditioned under this consent.

Reason: to ensure protection of vegetation proposed for retention on and adjacent to the site.
