The previous extension did not affect our view and the height of the building was not out of place in the northern area of Dee Why close to extensive parkland, bush reserve and beach.

In addition, more recent multi-storey buildings in Dee Why are very high but more acceptable due to their central location.

However this proposed development rising to 32 metres above ground level on the corner of Pittwater Rd and 23 metres across the remainder will totally change our outlook by blocking a lot of the sea and rural view and our sunlight, especially in winter. It will create a wind tunnel and will adversely affect the value of our property.
