Listed in Table 1 below are observations and calculations from the subject tree, including;

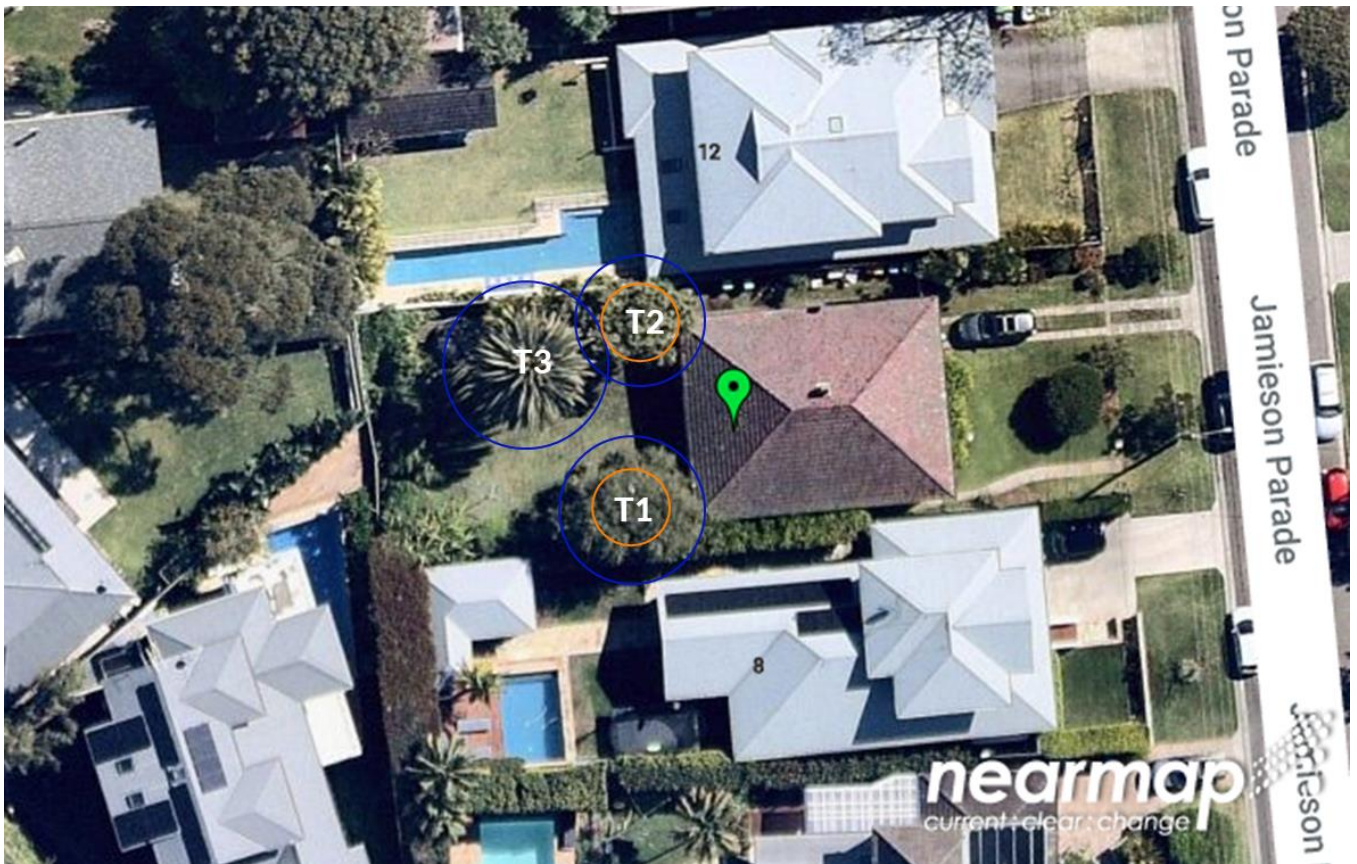
- Genus/species and common name,
