Last years rescue of an unconscious surfer from the south end would have been a death without that member on the club deck seeing the call for help. Newport is almost 1km of beach but visibility of the ocean is only possible for a very few location, one of which is the club in its current location. There is NO DOUBT the club need extensive renovations just to make it safe and fit for purpose but it MUST remain in its current location.
