DA 2019/1478.

I am requesting that my personal information (e.g. phone number, address, name, email address) will be redacted.

I am objecting because I am convinced that the Norfolk Island Pines that make this such a lovely area could be at risk of dying from damage to their roots.

These Norfolk Island Pines are part of the heritage of the area, an area I have lived in and valued for over 60 years. The council needs to value trees as part of our natural heritage. This development should not be approved as it is probable that these Norfolk pines will probably die within a few years of the development. It will take a lifetime to replace them if they die.

The land that they propose to develop is crown land. Crown land is for all of society, not just one user. This area adjacent to the car park is used by many people in the Northern Beaches.

As a person who walks regularly in the area, I find it is usually quiet from about 9 pm. I did not support having loud music played outdoor until 10 pm for 3 nights a week. The commercialisation of the area will change the ambience for both local residents and users of the caravan park.
