Wildlife corridors are essential to help ensure the survival of native species. If a species is surviving in 2 or more areas it is less likely to go extinct. If the species dies out in one area it can still survive in the other areas but is now more at risk of extinction because it is surviving in one less area.

If the two or more areas are linked by wildlife corridors the extinction of a species in one area is overcome by the species being able to repopulate the area by spreading back to the depopulated area through the wildlife corridor.
