I would like to submit my objection to DA1274/2017 because land with such biodiversity is too valuable for a variety of reasons and should not be destroyed for this 85 Unit development.

I find it hard to believe that an appeal has been lodged and NEW plans submitted by the developer in the Land and Environment Court to develop 7 apartment buildings in the middle of the designated high priority wildlife & coastal corridor, which is home to many vulnerable species, despite the refusal of the original DA by the Regional Panel for SEPP Seniors Housing in the Bayview Wildlife Corridor on many significant grounds including Substantial and Adverse impacts on the environment and despite the fact that there are overwhelming community objections and over 61,100 signatures.

I request that the appeal and new plans should be rejected for exactly the same reasons it was refused originally.
