Construction of Seniors Housing : 95 Units to be reduced to 85 Units .

I wish to update my **OBJECTION** to the **amended plans** (lodged by Mr Aaron Gadiel acting for Waterbrook Bayview Pty Ltd in the Land & Environment Court on 19<sup>th</sup> September 2018) **on behalf of 61,830 signatories** to a petition on Change.org to “*Ban any developments in Sydney’s Wildlife corridors*” .

Many of the signatories have submitted “individual” submissions to your Council

And this letter is on behalf of all the signatories that haven’t been able to submit submissions.

The **original petition** read as follows :

“Wildlife Corridors were created to allow Fauna to move freely between Habitats. Any proposed residential development on Bayview Golf course will prevent wildlife from moving between the coast at Winnererremy Bay Mona Vale and major habitat areas around Katandra Bushland Sanctuary and Nangana Road Bayview.

A second attempt for approval for a major building development was lodged in 2016 on this very Wildlife & Coastal corridor by REZONING from OPEN SPACE, that will completely cut this High Priority Wildlife Corridor (Map 9 Pittwater Council website) , isolating fauna from their feeding area in the remnant trees.

Many old remnant trees (159 trees , yes 159 to be exact) will have to be removed for building purposes.

Many Threatened and Endangered Native species owe their survival to these Wildlife Corridors and need this habitat for feeding and protection .

Please stop any further development in these Wildlife Corridors, particularly the ones in Bayview / Ingleside & across Sydney.”

***Amendments to the petition are as follows*** : Number of trees to be removed was 252 now reduced by 13 to **239 Mature trees with hollows**, habitat for vulnerable species .

The site is not considered to be suitable for the development given its location within an area which renders the development , as proposed , to be inconsistent with its “desired character” i.e.the proposal is **not in the public interest**.
