The paltry changes to the original DA for 60 Binalong Ave do not address any of the concerns voiced by local residents in submissions and at council and Land & Environment meetings.

These issues include

Increased traffic and lack of parking, no footpaths to Allambie Road, the development being out of character with surrounding homes, development on bushfire prone land, additional noise levels, inadequate bus services, R2 low density zone ... and the list goes on.

Nargong Rd, Jennifer Ave and Binalong Ave are quiet residential streets where many of the residents have lived their entire lives. We are not a transient population. We know our neighbours. We know the local shopkeepers. We know the local shops are over a kilometre away. We know we often have to pick up children / grandchildren in the evening because of the lack of public transport.

What we don't know is why we and the council have so little say in this type of development. How can the NSW government allow this type of development in such unsuitable locations, with little or no concern for the local residents.
