This wildlife corridor was established years ago with the following facts in mind; Isolated, small patches of habitat may be insufficient to sustain viable populations of some native species of fauna. In such instances, wildlife corridors, which are lines of native vegetation connecting separate habitat areas, are essential for maintaining biodiversity. Wildlife corridors enable fauna to access larger habitats by encouraging mobility between areas. Corridors may also assist native plant species to spread and colonise new areas over time.

Since establishment of this wildlife corridor and further urbanisation surrounding it, the number of native species have dwinded. Further development (urbanisation) of this corridor will impact fauna even further.
