We object to DA1274/2017 to develop 7 apartment buildings in the middle of the designated high priority wildlife and coastal corridor, home to many vulnerable animals and birds and other wildlife.

This is Biodiversity land and should not be destroyed by this 85 Unit development.

Despite the Refusal of this DA by the Regional Panel for SEPP Seniors Housing in the Bayview Wildlife Corridor on many significant grounds including Substantial and Adverse impacts on the environment and despite overwhelming community objections and over 61,100 signatures, an appeal has been lodged and NEW plans submitted by the developer in the Land and Environment Court. We do not want approval of this DA to progress - the wildlife corridor needs to remain in-tact for the environment and animals (there are many other places people can live - we are overdeveloped in Sydney already and another block of units is quite unnecessary).
