I object to DA1274/2017 to develop 7 apartment buildings in the middle of a designated high priority wildlife corridor which is home to many vulnerable species. This is Biodiversity land and should not be destroyed by a development for 85 units. The regional panel for SEPP Seniors Housing in the Bayview Wildlife Corridor has been refused on many significant grounds including substantial and adverse impacts on the environment. This decision must be upheld. Overwhelming community objections of more than 60,300 signatures cannot be ignored and the attempt by the developer to circumvent this by lodging an appeal with the Land and Environment Court is a gross dereliction of our duty to preserve valuable remaining wildlife corridors in Sydney. It is abhorrent to consider the destruction of local ecology for monetary gain will be permitted. The amended plans submitted by the developer to the Land and Environment court must be processed via the usual channels so that the community has an opportunity to assess and react to them. To do anything other than this lacks transparency and is a corruption of the democratic process. The developer's attempt to dodge the enormous public outcry over this development is obvious. They must be held accountable and the wildlife corridor must be preserved at all costs.
