The subject property and foreshore was inspected on 19 June 2019.

There is no evidence, within the confines of the properties of any threatened or endangered NSW coastal species listed in the EPBC Act 1999 of Threatened Species and Ecological communities including those which would be capable of surviving in sand and the poor quality soil of the subject property. (ref: www.environment.nsw.gov.au).

The foreshore sand is currently stabilized by rocks and coastal pigface (*Carpobrotus glaucescens*) and a few tufts of kikuyu grass. A small shrub (approx. 0.8m high) , possibly to be coastal *Mimosa*, mid-way along the property boundary, emerges from the mass of pigface,.
