In alignment with our local Councils, Cambridge Markets is reducing our environmental impact. Therefore Cambridge Markets has a strict no plastic and styrofoam policy. We expect the following at our markets:-

- No plastic bags of any kind. There are paper bag alternatives. Encourage customers to bring their own bags and baskets
- Bio-degradable cutlery
- No plastic containers, these are to be replaced with bamboo or cardboard containers.
- No plastic cups unless bio-degradable
- No styrofoam, these never break down and there are compostable alternatives
- No plastic straws unless biodegradable, we prefer paper straws
- Coffee cups - biodegradable cups. Please encourage people to bring their own. We would suggest a 50c discount if they do.
- Remove waste such as polluting substances including chemicals and cooking oil, are to be stored in a sealed container and removed for off-site disposal
- Reduce disposable water use. To speak to the local Councils or Sydney Water to see if they will provide a refill water station at the markets.

If you do choose to use plastic we require evidence that the product is biodegradable, recyclable, reusable or compostable. Compostable is the ultimate.
