I object to DA1274/2017.

The development of seven apartment buildings (with all the associated noise, bright lights and traffic) in the middle of a designated high priority wildlife corridor is absurd and NOT in the public interest. The wildlife corridor is home to many vulnerable species and is a priceless gem in an urban setting. Everyone knows how much value open space and native bushland add to an area - the leafy areas are the most desired!

This is Biodiversity land and should not be destroyed by this development - rather it should be preserved in perpetuity as a reminder of all that has already been lost from the area and as an example of how sometimes, humans can actually rule in favour of the environment.
