I hereby wish to submit my objection to the DA 1274/2017

I reside in the bush land area very close to the proposed development in Bayview and my concerns are for the wiping out of the natural habitat of quite a large number of creatures , including birds. This is most definitely going to block a high priority wildlife corridor The developers will be removing a minimum of 140 trees.By reducing the number of units from 95 to 85 is just a smoke screen in my opinion as they will still end up erecting the same number of buildings, three storeys high.

My concern is also for the owl population of this Bayview bush land area. Owl populations are reduced by baiting , but the biggest problem to owls is the proposed loss of habitat. Most owl species rely heavily on old growth trees with hollows for breeding. These hollows take many,many years to form. Trees in the whole area are being wiped out/ removed at an alarming rate. It would be so, so sad not to hear the nightly calls of the powerful owls to name but one.

Our precious wild life must not be allowed to be threatened like this. Please don't allow this proposal to go ahead.
