Statement of Significance

Length of foreshore including natural and built elements of the landscape. Rocky sandstone ledgers, beaches, mud flats and sandstone retaining walls and timber structures.

Fisher Bay Reserve

Statement of Significance

Natural bushland, aesthetic and scientific

Physical Description

Permanent bushland with creek, tidal flats, young mangroves. Bushland has a formed walking rack of timber deck construction due to steep slopes and vulnerability to erosion.

The proposal seeks consent for alterations and additions to an existing dwelling. It includes a minor extension to an existing deck and the installation of a pergola roof. The deck is located at the front of the dwelling within the Sandy Bay Road reserve. The heritage items are located to the south

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across the road, and to the south west. Given the small nature of the proposal and the physical distance to the heritage items, the proposal is considered to not impact upon the heritage items or their significance.
