It is with disappointment that I write to inform council of the concern as a resident of Wesley Street regarding the Two Proposals of development for Elanora Heights.

The two Proposals should be separated as the requirement whilst will require both parties in the development are still separate in the applications and are trying to piggy back on each development. Concerns are as follows

- The Elanora escarpment is a natural area that runs into the valley (from the mountain to the Sea) and to the much looked after Narrabeen Lake area. With the concern of development do you really think that this area will be looked after?
