Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent development on land, or within 40m of land, containing:

- All Development Applications on
- Actual or potential threatened species, populations, ecological communities, or their habitats;
- Wildlife corridors;
- Vegetation query stipulating that a Flora and Fauna Assessment is required;
- Vegetation query X type located in both A & C Wards;

And as such, Council's Natural Environment Unit officers are required to consider the likely potential environmental impacts.

Officer comments

The proposed modification has been assessed against the objectives of Manly LEP Clause 6.5 (Terrestrial Biodiversity). The modification is unlikely to result in additional impacts to native vegetation.

The proposal is therefore supported.
