Public meeting held by teleconference on 6 August 2025, opened at 1.30pm and closed at 1.52pm.

MATTER DETERMINED

PPSSNH-613 – Northern Beaches – DA2025/0077 at 10-28 Lawrence Street, Freshwater – Demolition works and construction of shop top housing including strata subdivision (as described in Schedule 1).

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

Application to vary a development standard:

Following consideration of a written request from the applicant, made under cl 4.6 (3) of the Warringah Local Environmental Plan 2011 (LEP), the Panel is not satisfied that the applicant has demonstrated that:

- a) compliance with cl. 4.3 (Height of Buildings) is unreasonable or unnecessary in the circumstances; and
- b) there are sufficient environmental planning grounds to justify contravening the development standard.

Development application

The Panel determined to refuse the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Panel determined not to uphold the Clause 4.6 variation to building height and refuse the application for the reasons numbered 1 to 11 outlined in Attachment 1 of the Council Assessment Report uploaded to the Portal on 23 July 2025, as amended by the Panel to include:

- New sub-clause iii. under Reason 1, as the Panel considers that Insufficient information has been provided with the application to allow for an adequate assessment of any view loss impacts on surrounding properties
- New dot point under ii. of Reason 2 referencing Part 4 H of the ADG, as the Panel considers the
 layout of some apartments is unsatisfactory to ensure intertenancy acoustic privacy where a living
 room abuts a neighbour's bedroom. Insufficient information has been provided with the
 application demonstrating this weakness in the design could be overcome by constructing these
 intertenancy walls to a standard that will safeguard the acoustic privacy between neighbours.
- Corrections to references to s.79C of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979.

As directed by the Panel, Council provided a revised and corrected list of reasons dated 7 August 2025, which was been uploaded to the Portal on 8 August 2025. The Panel accepts these as the final reasons for the refusal.

CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

In coming to its decision, the Panel considered written submissions made during public exhibition and heard from all those wishing to address the Panel during the public meeting. The Panel notes that issues of concern included:

- Bulk and scale
- LEP and DCP non-compliance
- Amenity including privacy and overshadowing
- Parking and traffic
- Construction impacts
- Impact on Freshwater Village including character
- Noise generated by waste collection
- Adequacy of Landscaping

The Panel considers that concerns raised by the community have been adequately addressed in the Assessment Report and that no new issues requiring assessment were raised during the public meeting.
