I write to you to voice my concerns in respect to the proposed rezoning of Heydon Estate and Uniting Church land, Ingleside & Elanora Heights (ref: R0005/03 & R0006/03).

My concerns are that the rezoning will have a negative affect the residents of Wesley St, Ingleside Rd, properties and natural environments below and in the water catchment path of the proposed rezoned site. Insofar as the proposal will:

- 1. Impact negatively in respect to existing residents in Wesley St. and Ingleside Rd.
- 2. Impact negatively on traffic on Wesley St. and Ingleside Rd, especially on the dangerous northern Entrance to Wesley St. from Powder Works Rd.
- 3. Impact negatively on the Fauna and Flora of the escarpment area and in the catchment path (Warriewood wetlands).
- 4. Seriously affect the current outlook up to the escarpment from across the Pittwater area.
- 5. That the rezoning of the Uniting Church conference centre should be considered as a separate application, and that:
 - a. Such an application should be free of inducements to the council in respect of denoted land.
 - b. That in the case of a rezoning that the residue lot be rezoned in line with commercial ventures operating within residential areas.
 - c. That in the case of rezoning appropriate rates are levied upon that land commensurate with the use of that land.

The above thoughts are only a brief outline of the concerns that I have and are only part of the total concerns that the residents of Wesley St. have.
