Planting & Maintenance Specification

- 1. Turf to be laid on 100mm topsoil over 150mm deep prepared area.
- 2. New planting beds to have quality compost mixed through existing soil.
- 3. Garden beds to be mulched with a minimum of 75 thick of mulch.
- 4. Garden beds to be fertilized after planting and watered well into soil.
- 5. Fertilizing should take place preferably during both Spring and Autumn.
- 6. Hedged species to be pruned every Spring and Autumn.
- 7. New trees to be secured with stakes to avoid rocking. Planting holes to be large enough for root ball and backfill of good quality planting mix.
