Once again I feel compelled to lodge an objection about the above development application .

Firstly this development is not consistent with the future characteristics of our already much destroyed local area. When we purchased and moved to Frenchs Forest some 30 years ago it was because it wasn't over crowded , it was a quiet area that was safe and good for our children to thrive in. There was an abundance of trees and wildlife that was beautiful to enjoy. The streets were quiet . It was a pleasure to go for a walk after work.

This development will dramatically increase traffic flow in narrow streets that are already now heavily burdened with excess traffic because of the monstrous hospital just up the road . Iris street is now a race track day and night ! Our streets were built for residential access not as a racetrack .

This site already has major issues like no public transport ,should that be addressed we go back to my originally complaint of the increased traffic and noise these small narrow streets will have to cope with. Poor access on foot with steep inclines on the street with no footpaths or walkways making it unsafe for elderly people. Street lights along this stretch are also poor. As we use this stretch of road frequently the traffic increase since the hospital build has increased by at least 3 or 4 times what it used to.

The wait time at the traffic lights to turn onto Wakehurst parkway has at least tripled that of just a couple of years ago.

Over the last few years we have seen a dramatic decrease in natural wildlife in our area. Not to mention the ridiculous amount of native trees already killed by the hospital development. Plenty of which were completely unnecessary. Our once beautiful green Frenchs forest is now a concrete jungle ... often referred to now as just Frenchs because there's no forest any more!!!

In conclusion I'd like to say that had local residents who have lived the entire lives in this area we strongly object to any more over development in the area. Especially this concrete jungle again on our doorstep disrupting our once beautiful neighbourhood .
