Regarding the second stage of building at 38 Lagoon Street Narrabeen Mod2023/0044 - DA2022/0071.

I would hope that the massive gum trees I am about to mention will have the tops of the trees cut back to a safe height, so they will not fall onto my roof and damage my house at 40 Lagoon St Narrabeen.

There are several large gum trees on the owners eastern boundary bordering 38 Lagoon Street Narrabeen and adjoining boundary of 36 Lagoon St Narrabeen.

In very high winds I hear the tall gum trees hitting very loudly against each other, as they are extremely tall with quite thin trunks. I am concerned, due to the extreme height of these trees, that if one of the trees uprooted itself it could fall through the roof of my bedroom at 40 Lagoon St Narrabeen or fall down and damage my brick fence on my southern boundary.

I repeat I would like to have several metres taken off the tops of the gum trees
