I write to you requesting approval for the complete tree removal of the above

This Eucalyptus Nicholii is located in the front yard of the property only 1.5 metres from the structure and foundations of the dwelling.

The tree has a large lean in the trunk and the canopy spreads over the dwelling. footpath and main road being Warringah Road and contains substantial dieback within the canopy.

This tree is fully matured and believed to be close to the end of its recognised life span in which Eucalyptus Nicholii are know to live a maximum of 25-30 years. Eucalyptus Nicholii are also a known species to have poor branch attachment and known to shed major limbs they are also known to have a high chance of failure during windstorms and this tree takes the brunt of southerly storms that hit. This has already occurred previously and if it were to happen again it could cause major structure damage to the dwelling or to passing pedestrians or vehicles, which frequent past the property regularly as it is a busy main road and there is a bus stop located approx 20 metres from the tree.

We are requesting approval of full tree and stump removal and replacing the immediate area with more appropriate small native specimens.

Can I request that the Tree Removal Officer that comes to inspect the tree please contact me prior to the day so that I can arrange to meet with them at my property and discuss the application in person.
