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


Figure 1 - Site Plan and Effluent Management Area

APPROVAL TO INSTALL AN ON-SITE SEWAGE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM SECTION 68 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1993

Council hereby grants Approval to Install the On-site Sewage Management System at the above address under Section 68 of the Local Government Act 1993.

The applicant must comply with the attached conditions of approval.

Prior to operation of the On-Site Sewage Management System, the applicant is required to apply for an Approval to Operate an On-site Sewage Management System.

- 1. The design, installation and operation of the system shall comply with the following requirements (but not limited to):
 - a) Local Government Act 1993;
 - b) Local Government (General) Regulation 2005;
 - c) The Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997:
 - d) The Department of Local Government's Environment & Health Protection Guidelines: On-site Sewage Management for Single Households (1998);
 - e) The relevant Australian Standards (included but not limited too AS 1547:2000 & 1546:1998);
 - f) Conditions as stipulated on the certificate of accreditation issued the NSW Health Department.
- 2. All plumbing is to be completed by an appropriately licensed qualified plumber in accordance with the 'NSW Code of Practice: Plumbing and Drainage 3rd Edition 2006' and the National Plumbing and Drainage Code AS3500 Parts 1, 2, 3 & 4. No alterations or additions to plumbing into and out of the system are permitted without the approval of Council.
- 3. All irrigation pipe work and fittings shall comply with AS 2698 "Plastic Pipes and Fittings for Irrigation and Rural Applications"; and
 - Standard household hose fittings shall not be used;
 - The irrigation system shall not be capable of connection to the mains water supply:
 - Be of a suitable type and quality which prevents the intrusion of roots into the system; and
 - Recycled effluent pipelines must be coloured lilac, and any connection points clearly labelled "treated wastewater – not fit for human consumption".
- 4. Full water reduction features (AAA rated) must be installed in the dwelling, including but not limited to:
 - Aerated faucets in the kitchen and bathrooms;
 - Shower flow restrictors <6L/minute;
 - Dual flush (6/3L) toilets.
- 5. All electrical work (if required) must be carried out by a licensed electrician and in accordance with the relevant provisions of AS/NZS 3000.
- 6. All sub-surface irrigation lines are to be fixed in place by burial to a depth no less than 100mm below the surface.
- 7. The irrigation area must be protected to prevent stormwater water entering the area.



- 8. Within the land application areas there shall be at least two warning signs that comply with AS 1319 which have:
 - a green background;
 - 20mm high Series C lettering in black or white; and
 - the words: "RECLAIMED EFFLUENT NOT FOR DRINKING AVOID CONTACT"
- 9. The land application area must:
 - be landscaped appropriately and maintained free from overgrown vegetation at all times;
 - not be used to grow fruit or salad vegetables; and
 - be protected from possible vehicle and animal damage.
- 10. All effluent from the onsite wastewater treatment system shall be disposed of within the boundaries of the premises. The irrigation system must be operated in such a manner as to prevent run-off of effluent from the land application area.
- 11. The owner/occupier shall enter into an annual service contract, requiring servicing according to the manufacturer's specifications and include inspection of all irrigation areas. Inspection reports are to be submitted to Council for review.
- 12. Noise generated from the pumps used in the system must not breach the noise provisions of the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997.*
- 13. The system shall be installed in accordance with the report and site plan prepared by Strategic Environmental & Engineering Consulting dated 18 October 2017.
- 14. Swimming pool back wash being disposed of to an alternative disposal area without impact on the effluent disposal area.

PRIOR TO OPERATION

- 15. Provide certification from a wastewater consultant that the system has been installed in accordance with the report and site plan prepared by Strategic Environmental & Engineering Consulting titled Wastewater Site and Soil Assessment for proposed residential Development at Lot 10 DP239957 No. 3 Torumba Ave Bayview SEEC Ref No: 17000321-WW-01 Dated 18 October 2017 and the Conditions as stipulated on the certificate of accreditation issued the NSW Health Department.
- 16. The system must not be operated until an approval to operate has been granted by Council.

Please Note: this approval is only for the installation of the on-site waste water management system and does not grant approval for any other compliance matters that may be ongoing with other Council departments.




Figure 1 - Site Plan and Effluent Management Area
