Re: Mod 2017/0071 increase in student numbers. I would like to object to the increase in students from 884 to 1092. Reasons: traffic on headland road and 'drop off' ie 7.45am to 9.00am and 'pick up' from 2.30pm - 3.30pm is extremely dangerous for students, residents and businesses in the area. Parents are parking illegally continually and existing by big trucks, tradesmen vehicles and car out of our factory complex is like playing 'chicken'. The report suggests that the current car spaces of 133 will adequately accomodate teachers and students - this is not true they are currently parking everywhere even in our factory complex illegally. Year 12 students being increased from 83 to 115 equates to even more "P" plate drivers using the area for their parking. The report also suggests that there will be no increase in required teachers - an additional 208 students will definitely require more teachers, to suggest otherwise is laughable. The Under Hall parking spots of 15 are usually used by tradesmen and delivery men working or coming to the school.
