Note: If the proposal, when compliant with Northern Beaches Council Development Control Plan – Part C9 Waste Management, causes inconsistencies with other parts of the approval i.e. architectural or landscaped plans a modification(s) to the development may be required.

Reason: To ensure adequate and appropriate waste and recycling facilities are provided. (DACWTC01)

CONDITIONS TO BE COMPLIED WITH DURING DEMOLITION AND BUILDING WORK

Waste/Recycling Requirements (Waste Plan Submitted)

During demolition and/or construction the proposal/works shall be generally consistent with the submitted Waste Management Plan titled [INSERT] and dated [INSERT].

Reason: To ensure waste is minimised and adequate and appropriate waste and recycling facilities are provided. (DACWTE01)

Waste/Recycling Requirements (Materials)

During demolition and/or construction the following materials are to be separated for recycling – timber – bricks – tiles – plasterboard – metal – concrete, and evidence of disposal for recycling is to be retained on site.

Reason: To ensure waste is minimised and recovered for recycling where possible. (DACWTE02)

CONDITIONS WHICH MUST BE COMPLIED WITH PRIOR TO THE ISSUE OF THE OCCUPATION CERTIFICATE

Garbage and Recycling Facilities

All internal walls of the storage area shall be rendered to a smooth surface, coved at the floor/wall intersection, graded and appropriately drained to the sewer with a tap in close proximity to facilitate cleaning.

Details demonstrating compliance are to be submitted to the Principal Certifying Authority prior to the issue of any interim / final Occupation Certificate.

Reason: To prevent pollution of the environment and to protect the amenity of the area.(DACPLF03)

Waste and Recycling Facilities Certificate of Compliance

The proposal shall be constructed in accordance with Northern Beaches Council Development Control Plan – Part C9 Waste Management

Details demonstrating compliance are to be submitted to the Principal Certifying Authority prior to the issue of any interim / final Occupation Certificate.

ON-GOING CONDITIONS THAT MUST BE COMPLIED WITH AT ALL TIMES

Private contractor conditions for on going waste collection

Private contractor conditions for on going waste collection

- The appointed contractor is to collect waste bins from the waste storage room and return bins immediately to the waaste storage room.

Under no circumstance are bins to be left on the street, pavement or public areas for any period of time.

- Contractor to collect bins from East Esplanade.

Reason: To ensure public areas are free of waste bins (DACHEGOG1)

Commercial Waste and Recycling Storage

Commercial waste and recycling material/storage bins must be stored in a separate area to the residential waste and recycling material/storage bins as shown on the approved plans.

Reason: To ensure that commercial waste and residential waste is not mixed and is properly managed. (DACPLG19)

Commercial Waste Collection

Waste and recyclable material, generated by this premises, must not be collected between the hours of 9pm and 8am on any day.

Reason: To ensure the acoustic amenity of surrounding properties. (DACPLG24)
