Development Application

Development Application No.DA2012/0229 was rejected by Council on 13 March 2012 pursuant to Clause 51 of EP&A Regulation 2000 on the basis that the Application failed to provide the following:

• **Elevational shadow diagrams** in accordance with Part D6 – Access to Sunlight of the Warringah Development Control Plan.

Reasons for Review of Application

The applicant has lodged an application under the provision of s 82B of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1997 and provided elevation shadow diagrams to address the reasons for rejection of Development Application No.DA2012/0229.

SECTION 82B OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PLANNING AND ASSESSMENT ACT 1979

Under Section 82B of the EPA Act, an applicant may request Council to review the decision to reject and not determine the application. The following table provides an assessment against the criteria of Section 82B review:

Has supporting information been provided to explain the applicant's request for review of Council's decision?	Supporting information including, shadow elevation diagrams prepared by Classic Country Cottages, dated March 2012 has been provided to satisfy the applicant's request for review of Council's decision.	Yes

Conclusion

It is considered that the review is consistent with the provisions of section 82(B) of the EPA Act, 1979 and therefore it is recommended that Council proceed with the assessment and determination of the Application.
