Reference is made to the proposed development at the above area and Aboriginal heritage.

An archaeological assessment under the *Due Diligence Code of Practice for the Protection of Aboriginal Objects in New South Wales* (2010). Is recommended based on the following:

- A number of registered Aboriginal sites are located within 200m of the subject area

A Due Diligence Aboriginal heritage assessment should be completed for the subject area to confirm if Aboriginal objects are located or area likely to be located within the subject area. All Aboriginal objects, including those which are not registered, are protected under the NPW Act.

Under the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974 (NPW Act) all Aboriginal objects are protected. Should any Aboriginal Cultural Heritage items be uncovered during earthworks, works should cease in the area and the Aboriginal Heritage Office assess the finds. Under Section 89a of the NPW Act should the objects be found to be Aboriginal, Heritage NSW and the Metropolitan Local Aboriginal Land Council (MLALC) should be contacted
