Discussion of reason for referral

Details of heritage items affected

Statement of Significance

Socially significant as plantings undertaken by the local community to commemorate those who had died in WWI. Aesthetically a visual dominant planting with important streetscape qualities. Physical Description

Established Brushbox trees (Lophostomen Confertus) along both sides of the street. All trees on southern side of the street have been excessively pruned by Sydney Electricity. Only 2 of the original tree guards remaining.

Consideration of Application

The proposal seeks consent for alterations and additions to an existing dwelling and detached garage. The proposed works include the demolition of the existing detached garage located in the south-west rear corner of the subject site. A proposed new single detached garage is to be constructed in the same location. Further proposed works include the construction of a new pergola located at the rear of the existing dwelling which is to cover an existing paved area. The subject site adjoins a heritage item containing several street trees which line Soldiers Avenue. Heritage notes that there are no significant street trees within the immediate vicinity of the subject site. Given the small scale of the proposed works, the impact of the proposal upon the heritage significance of the heritage item is considered acceptable.

Therefore, no objections are raised on heritage grounds and no conditions are required.
